ONE PLACE FAMILY JUSTICE CENTER AT ZONTA'S MAY MEETING**

(Montgomery) - The Zonta Club of Montgomery will be meeting on Tuesday, May 4, 2010 at the Capital City Club. Our guest speakers, **Chief Justice Sue Bell Cobb** and **Montgomery County District Attorney Ellen Brooks**, will be speaking about the **One Place Family Justice Center**. The Center's Executive Director, **Steve Searcy**, will also be in attendance.

Montgomery's One Place Family Justice Center will be the first Family Justice Center in Alabama. The concept is based on a national model, which aims to serve victims of domestic violence and certain other crimes under one roof rather than following the traditional model of having victims navigate various bureaucracies to receive the services they need.

Following our speakers, the business portion of the meeting will be conducted. This will include the installation of new officers and a report on our recent (and very successful) pancake breakfast fundraiser to support Aid to Inmate Mothers.
